- 3. You are responsible for mailing your scholarship application(s). MAIL EARLY!!! (See your College & Career Specialist or Counselor at least one week before deadline for mailing assistance)
- 4. If the application requires a school transcript, please complete the appropriate request form available in your school counseling office and submit it least 3 weeks prior to the mailing deadline date.
- 5. Be sure to make requests for counselors and/or teacher recommendations <u>at least</u> 2 weeks prior to mailing deadline.
