

Job Title: ESL Instructor-Adult Education Job Classification: Non-Exempt Supervisor: Coordinator, Dropout Recovery and Regional Program Manager

Job Summary

The ESL teacher is responsible for providing English instruction to limited English proficient adult students including curriculum development, evaluation of students' progress, and accurate maintenance of all students' records. Classroom instruction should be interactive and incorporate a variety of teaching techniques, materials and resources.

Essential Duties

- 1. Provide English Instruction to limited English proficient adult students
- 2. Develop and implement instructional lessons based on student's proficiency level using content standards
- 3. Provides on-going to feedback to students and coordinators
- 4. Analyzes student progress to identify areas for improvement
- 5. Attends staff development, training and professional activities to improve/maintain knowledge of ESL
- 6. Administers formative and summative assessments

Other Duties

1. Performs any other related duties as assigned by the Coordinator of Dropout Recovery, Regional Program Manager or Program Specialist.
