Hometown Grant Funding 2025

Are you an NNPS High School Graduate and meet the eligibility for this grant opportunity?



This grant provides a stipend of \$7,500 per academic year, for up to four years (contingent upon available funding), for individuals who meet the following criteria:

Eligibility Criteria:

- 1. The teacher graduated from a public high school in the school division in which they are currently employed;
- 2. The teacher was eligible for free lunch during the applicant's attendance at a public high school in the local school division; and
- 3. The teacher is teaching, within one year of graduating from an institution of higher education in the Commonwealth, with a commitment to teach for a period of at least four years, at a public school at which at least 40 percent of students qualify for free lunch in the school division in which such individual graduated from high school.

To be considered for selection, applicants must submit a completed VDOE Hometown Teacher application to kimberly.hammond@nn.k12.va.us in Human Resources Office by March 3, 2025. Please note that all applications will be reviewed by a regional selection committee and only four candidates from Superintendent's Region II will be recommended.
